

Penn Treaty Archaeology Center Now Open 324 Richmond Street

Thursdays 12pm-4pm & Saturdays 11am-3pm

The Archaeology Center serves as a functioning archaeological lab, where artifacts excavated from the I-95/Girard Avenue Improvement Project are processed and studied by AECOM archaeology staff. Visitors will be able to watch archaeologists work with the artifacts and interact with them about their work and project discoveries. There are also numerous artifact exhibits and interpretive displays related to the history and archaeology of the Delaware Waterfront (history going back to about 7,000 B.C.!). Currently the Center is open to residents of the local Port Richmond, Fishtown, and Northern Liberties neighborhoods on Thursdays, from 12:00 - 4:00 pm, and on Saturdays from 11:00 am - 3:00 pm. The Center is located at 324 Richmond St., at the northwest corner of Columbia and Delaware Avenues, and directly across from Penn Treaty Park. Visitors can enter through the main door on Columbia Avenue.

Senior Farmers' Market Produce Vouchers

Philadelphia Corporation for Aging (PCA) will begin distributing Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) produce vouchers Monday, June 24, as part of an annual program to encourage seniors to eat more fresh fruits and vegetables. Eligible Philadelphia seniors can receive \$20 worth of vouchers (four vouchers, each valued at \$5) that can be used to purchase fresh Pennsylvaniagrown produce sold at certified farmers' markets throughout Philadelphia and the surrounding area. Incomeeligible Philadelphia residents who will be 60 or older by December 31 of this year, may receive the vouchers at PCA, 642 North Broad Street in Philadelphia (weekdays, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.) and at other designated sites. A popular distribution location where the vouchers can be spent on-site is the Reading Terminal Market, Rick Nichols Room, at 12th and Arch streets. Vouchers will be distributed there July 17 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
